

## Winter survival kit for your car

Winter travel can be a potentially hazardous proposition. Especially when traveling longer distances, it's important to keep a survival kit on hand that would allow you to make it through 24 hours with out a car heater. A recommended list might include:

- 1 Sleeping bag and/or heavy blanket per person
- 3 lb. Coffee can to heat water
- Matches (waterproof), candles, a good flashlight and extra batteries
- Extra winter clothing especially hats, gloves and heavy socks
- First aid kit
- Bottled water (allow room for expansion as it may freeze)
- High-energy foods, trail mix, energy bars etc.
- Sand or kitty litter (for traction)
- Shovel, flat blade preferably
- Basic tool kit incl: pliers, screwdrivers, adjustable wrench, tape and wire.
- Paper towels or toilet paper
- Axe or saw for cutting firewood or placing branches under tires for traction
- Tow chain or strap
- Wire and rope
- Starter fluid, extra oil, gas line deicer and booster cables
- Signaling devices such as flares
- Cell phone and car charger
